**ORDINANCE NO. 17 - 2008**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE AND PROHIBITING PARKING ON PORTIONS OF MATHEWS AVENUE**

**WHEREAS**, Mathews Avenue is a municipal road located in the Borough of Riverdale; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale find that portions of Mathews Avenue are not appropriate for parking.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Riverdale shall be amended to include the following additional no parking regulation:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Descriptions</u>
Mathews Avenue	Both	Between the intersection with DeGraw and a point 530' in a Southerly direction
Mathews Avenue	Both	Between the intersection with DeGraw Road and a point 220' in a Northerly direction
Mathews Avenue	One	Beginning at the intersection of Mathews Avenue and Hemlock Street on the Eastern side of Mathews Avenue, a distance of 120' in a Southerly direction

**Section 2.** If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

**Section 3.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
