ORDINANCE NO. 2-2007

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE AND PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE SENIOR COMMUNITY CENTER BY PRIVATE GROUPS, ORGANIZATIONS, AND INDIVIDUALS

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the Borough Senior Community Center to be available under certain circumstances for use by groups, organizations, or individuals; and

WHEREAS, the use of the Senior Community Center should be regulated to fully protect Borough property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Riverdale shall be amended by the inclusion of new Chapter 159 which shall be entitled "Use of the Senior Community Center," and shall read in its entirety as follows:

Chapter 159

Use of the Senior Community Center

§ 159-1. Use of the Senior Community Center by private groups, organizations, or individuals shall be permitted only under the terms and conditions set forth in this Section.

§ 159-2. Use of the Senior Community Center by private groups, organizations, or individuals shall be subject to rules and regulations established by the Mayor and Borough Council and it shall be a violation of this Ordinance and the failure to comply with the rules and regulations shall be a violation of this Ordinance.

§ 159-3. The use of the Senior Community Center by a private group, organization, or individual shall be limited to Borough residents only. There shall be no use fee for residents use of the Senior Community Center but there shall be a restoration fee of

\$50.00 which shall be paid when a reservation to use the Senior Community Center is made and shall be nonrefundable. A security deposit in the amount of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars shall be required from any private group, organization, or individual utilizing the Senior Community Center.

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
